PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

Richard's Painter's Pride Wall Guard "First Coat" Drywall Primer/Sealer is specially formulated for use on interior wallboard and drywall surfaces that exhibit a yellowish bleed and/or discoloration due to the use of recycled paper currently being used in the manufacture of these types of substrates. Its special alkyd modified acrylic formulation helps prevent the bleeding from affecting finish coat applications. It provides excellent coverage, applies easily, has excellent sealing qualities, product versatility and creates a more suitable surface for the application of both latex and oil-based finish paint coatings. **FOR INTERIOR USE ONLY!**

SURFACE PREPARATION

GENERAL: The entire surface area to be painted should be clean, dry, sound and free from all dirt, grease, oils, waxes, mildew and any other surface contaminants. New masonry and/or cementitious surfaces should be tested for "alkali" content before paint application. When applying to wood surfaces, it is recommended to test a small surface area for any signs of "tannic acid bleed". Remove any loose scale, chalked, cracked or peeling paint from previously painted surfaces by hand scraping, sanding, wire brushing and/or power tool cleaning. Mildew - Surface areas affected by mildew should be washed with a commercial mildew removal product carefully following manufacturer's application and safety directions. Rinse thoroughly with clean water, and allow a minimum of 24 hours to dry thoroughly.

WARNING! If you scrape, sand, or remove old paint, you may release lead dust. LEAD IS TOXIC. EXPOSURE TO LEAD DUST CAN CAUSE SERIOUS ILLNESS, SUCH AS BRAIN DAMAGE, ESPECIALLY IN CHILDREN. PRODUCT APPLICATION

Richard's Painter's Pride Wall Guard "First Coat" Drywall Primer/Sealer may be easily applied with a good quality brush, roller, or airless spray equipment. For best results, it is recommended to apply by brush and/or roller to effectively work primer into surface pores. If applying with a brush, apply a smooth and generous coat application on/in small surface areas, such as trim or cutting-in larger surface areas. If applying with a roller cover, apply an even and generous coat application in a "M" or crisscross motion, avoiding any excessive respreading or reworking. Maintain a wet edge during application by brushing/rolling into previously applied coating areas. If applying by airless spray equipment, it is recommended to use a unit with a minimum of 2000 psi of pressure, with a 0.015 - 0.019 fluid spray tip. During spray application, the surface area should be back-rolled to insure proper adhesion, an even coat application and to effectively work primer into surface pores. Allow primer/sealer to dry thoroughly before applying recommended finish coatings. Apply when surface and ambient temperatures are above 55° F. and below 90° F. **Keep From Freezing!**

PRECAUTIONS

<u>CAUTION</u>: **KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN!** Keep away from heat, sparks and open flames. **USE WITH ADEQUATE VENTILATION!** Where ventilation is inadequate, use a suitable respirator. Avoid prolonged contact with skin and breathing of vapors and/or spray mists. When spraying this material, use an **OSHA** approved cartridge respirator. Use chemical safety glasses, goggles, or a face shield for proper eye protection. Wash thoroughly after handling and before eating or smoking. Close container after each use.

MIXING INSTRUCTIONS & PACKAGING

Stir thoroughly and apply as it comes from the container. **No Thinning Is Necessary!** However, if thinning is required, you may add **Clean Water** up to ½ pint per gallon.
